








- Rectal Palpation
 - Immediate diagnosis
 - Low cost (\$3-5/hd)
 - Highly accurate
 - Experienced veterinarian
 - Stage of pregnancy
 - As early as 30 days










Ultrasonography

- Immediate diagnosis
- Low cost (\$3-5/hd)
- As early as 26 days
- Heartbeat
- Detection of twins
- Accurate fetal measurements and aging
- Fetal sexing






- Male day 65
- Female day 65








Ultrasonography - Fetal Sexing



Male – day 65 of gestation
Female – day 65 of gestation





- Blood test Pregnancy Associated Glycoproteins (PAG)
 - As early as
 - 25 days heifers
 - 28 days cows
 - High accuracy: 99% when cow is open
 - 60 to 90 days post calving
 - Not chute side 1 to 2 weeks to receive results
 - Low Cost \$2.50 to \$5.00
 - Need to collect blood!
