The beef cattle program strives to raise the most predictable genetics available and will feature both purebred and commercial beef cattle. Breeders of purebred Hereford, Simmental, Charolais, and Angus cattle will be able to select Al-sired progeny from a cross-section of the VT Beef Cattle herd. The purebred females are sired by and mated to recognized, proven, and popular breed-leading Al sires and will provide a golden investment opportunity for those who have limited Al knowledge or expertise. These females combine curve-bending GE-EPDs with proven production records while our promising herd sires stem from predictable cow families. All seven spring-born calves will sell separately from their dams. A strong set of commercial cows (both fall and spring-calving) and bred heifers of SimAngus origin will also be offered. SaleRing.live will provide online bidding for the cattle sale if you feel more comfortable with that format. If so, you must register at www.salering.live/register at least 15 minutes before the sale using Google Chrome in order to watch/bid online in real-time. Complimenting this service, video is available on all sale cattle which can be accessed at https://www.apsc.vt.edu/facilities0/beef-center.html or at www.salering.live. Sale cattle will be on display throughout the week of the sale but will not be brought into the sale ring which is different from earlier years.

Our equine program is selling an excellent online offering of five quality youngstock and two riding-age horses. Please join us as we showcase these well-bred horses from 12-6 PM on sale day. The online auction will be open for bidding on October 15th and will close promptly at 6:00 PM on October 28th.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Cattle sell under the Standard Terms and Conditions as suggested by the American Hereford Association, American Angus Association, American-International Charolais Association, and the American Simmental Association. Cash or good check will be accepted. All purchases are to be settled for at the conclusion of the sale and will remain at the VT Beef Center until proper settlement is made.

REGISTRATIONS & TRANSFER:

Registration certificates will be transferred to the buyer at the seller's expense. Buyers must provide full name and address for transfer. Association member codes would be helpful if you are a member of a purebred breed association; however, this is not required to purchase cattle. Animal transfers will be done after settlement.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. All cattle for sale will meet the health requirements of the Commonwealth of Virginia and appropriate health papers will be furnished for interstate shipment. Every female (4-12 mo.) has been calf-hood vaccinated for Brucellosis. All sale cattle are tested free from Brucellosis, Johne's Disease, and Bovine Leukemia Virus (BLV).
- 2. If sale cattle are returned to the seller for an adjustment, they must meet health requirements of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 3. Yearling bulls have undergone a breeding soundness examination (BSE) and are considered satisfactory breeders as defined by the Society of Theriogenology. Buyers will be given a copy of the BSE results.

BREEDING GUARANTEE:

Bulls are guaranteed to be breeders (defined as the ability to settle healthy cows by the time they are 14 months of age) with exception of:

a. Injury or disease occurring to the animal after time of purchase. b. Gross negligence or willful misconduct on the part of the purchaser.

HERD HEALTH:

All pregnant females were given a pre-breeding vaccine which consisted of a modified-live virus IBR-PI3, BVD, BRSV, and a 5-way Lepto bacterin. Any questions concerning general herd health can be directed to Dr. Terry Swecker, College of Veterinary Medicine (0442), Virginia Tech, Blacksburg, VA 24061, 540/231-7375.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Announcements from the auction block will take precedence over printed material in this sale book. Virginia Tech reserves the right to withdraw any sale lot from the sale that does not meet their specifications prior to the sale.

EPDs represented in this sale book were current at the time requested for the layout and printing of this sale book. EPDs are recalculated throughout the year by the respective breed associations, which mean the figures represented in this book may change for these animals in the future.
